


#### Operating precautions

5 Flat washer ··· 8pcs

(12 pcs for Type 2)



- \*For Type 1, the two bases(top and bottom plates) are identical.
- \*For Type 2, the top plate is diffrently shaped from the bottom plate. Take care not to confuse them.


#### Composition of parts.



3-2 Next, tilt guide rail unit B towards you as shown in the photo.


#### Assembly procedure \*Assemble the parts in numerical order: 11 to 4.

from above,



For Type 2, before installing guide rail unit A, attach the spacer (a part designed specifically for Type 2)to the base (at two locations).




### 3 Installing guide rail unit B


